Warming Temperatures This Week

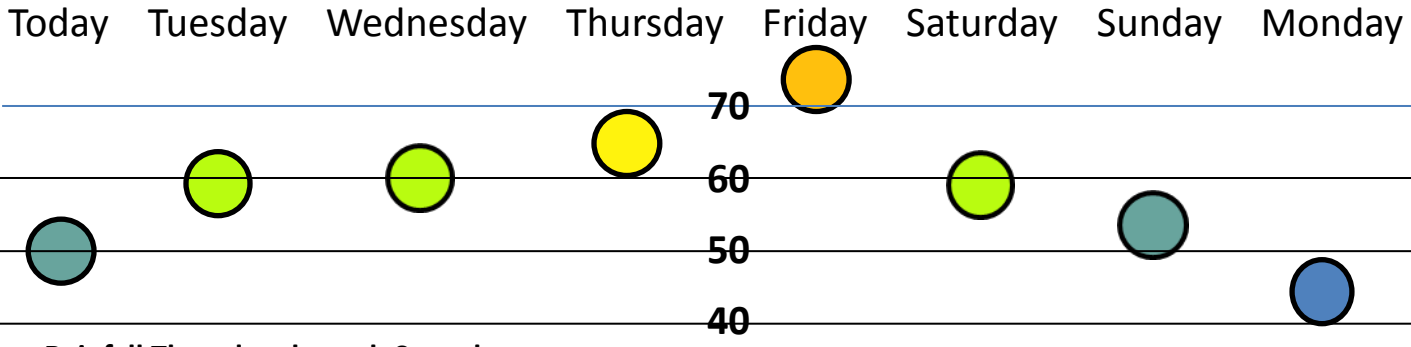
Accelerated snowmelt is expected, as temperatures rise to around 50 today and 60 on Tuesday

High pressure will settle over the Carolinas through mid-week, holding daytime temperatures in the 60s

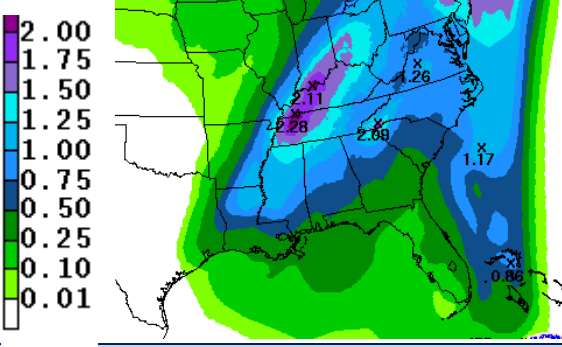
A warm front lifting north, will bring areas of rain late Thursday and early Friday, followed by warming into the 70s Friday afternoon

A cold front will cross the coast Saturday with a few showers, opens the door for a surge of colder air Sunday and early next week, though not as cold as the recent air

Road Ice Update

As much of the road ice and snow melts today, milder low temperatures overnight in the middle and upper 30s, should prevent re-freezing Tuesday morning
