



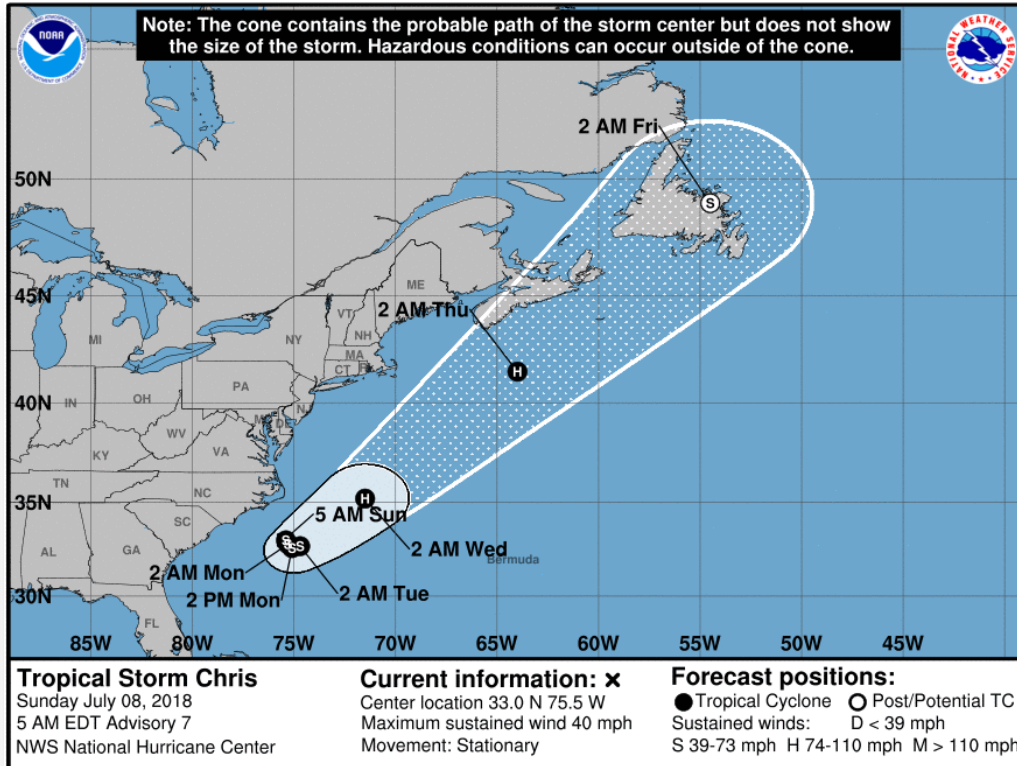
Tropical Storm Chris

Issued: 8:15 AM Sunday July 8, 2018

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Overview: As of 5 AM EDT, TD #3 was upgraded to Tropical Storm Chris. The tropical storm was located approximately 160 miles east of Cape Fear NC. TS Chris is forecast to meander off the NC coast through Monday before lifting to the northeast late Monday night through Friday. Chris could strengthen into a hurricane as it moves away to the northeast.

Potential Impacts: Mainly maritime impacts are expected including: rough surf, strong rip currents, strong longshore currents, and steep waves at inlet entrances. Otherwise, no direct impacts from TS Chris are anticipated.

Recommendations: No protective measures are warranted at this time. All marine interests should continue to monitor the progress of TS Chris.
