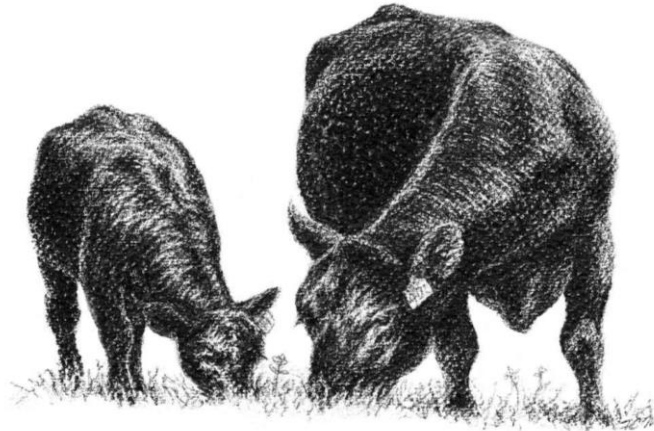


**2020 Cape Fear Regional Conference
