## Dry & Cold Weather in Store for the Weekend

**Overview:** Unseasonably cold high pressure continues to build across the eastern US today through the weekend. Well below normal temperatures today and Saturday will begin to return to normal Sunday. No chance of rain through early next week.

Widespread freezing temperatures expected Saturday morning across SE NC and NE SC, with greater coverage than Friday morning's freeze. Frost possible Sunday morning.

Freeze Warning in effect for all areas for forecasted temps as low as 28°F, with exception of Freeze Watch for Georgetown County, SC due to greater uncertainty.

Elevated fire danger Friday due to low relative humidities and gusty N-NW winds.

Small Craft Advisory for coastal waters through 1pm Friday for northerly winds 15-25 kts and gusts up to 30 kts.

Great Pee Dee River at Pee Dee remains in minor flood stage. Will gradually fall into next week, and expected to remain in flood until further notice. [More info here](#)
