### OVERVIEW:

Warm weather will continue with well above normal temperatures and early morning dense fog possible through midweek. Clouds will increase into Wednesday ahead of a cold front with increasing chance of showers, especially late Wednesday when thunderstorms are possible. Drier and cooler weather will arrive Thursday into Friday.

### LAND HAZARDS:

Overnight into early morning dense fog possible through Wednesday morning. Marginal risk (Level 1 of 5) of severe thunderstorms on Wednesday ahead of cold front and mainly west of I-95.

### MARINE HAZARDS:

A Small Craft Advisory is possible Wednesday night and Thursday as a cold front moves across the area.

### HYDROLOGY:

No river flooding expected this week.

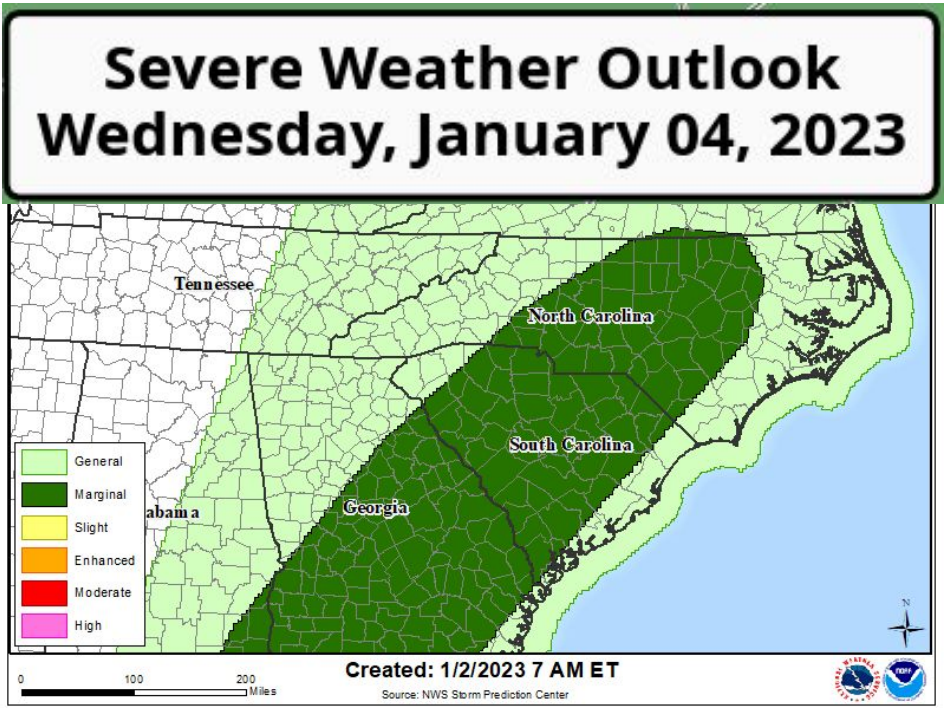
