

Vietnam War Era Veterans Commemoration



The Raymond W. Biglow VFW Post 8062 will be hosting a National Vietnam War Veterans Day on Mar. 29, 2024. The commemoration recognizes all who served on active duty in the U. S. Armed Forces at any time during the period of November 1, 1955 to May 15, 1975.



As part of that ceremony, as a lasting memento of the nation's gratitude, veterans will receive the Vietnam Veterans Lapel Pin shown below. Surviving spouses of those who served will also be recognized. This includes veterans classified as "Vietnam Era Veterans." Everyone who served during that time played a role, thus the saying, "All gave some, some gave all."

According to the Vietnam War Commemoration organization, 7 million Vietnam era veterans served during this tumultuous time in American history. The Vietnam Veterans Memorial Wall in Washington, DC bears the names of 58,281 men and women who were lost in that conflict.
